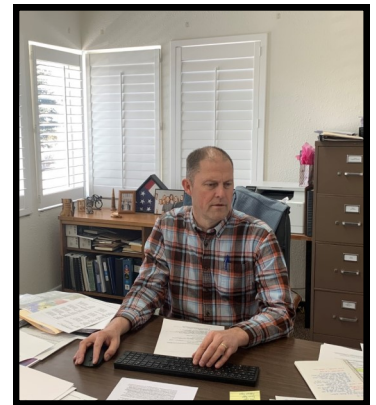
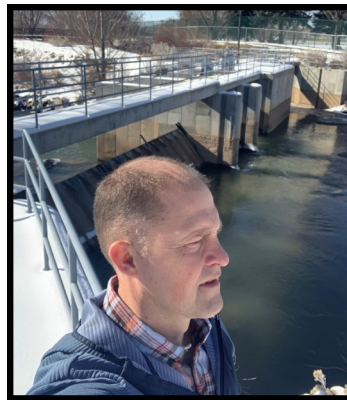


# ***WATER PROTECTORS IN THE FIELD***
